Credit for research papers, prior experience and modules

All research projects are to be completed using the analytical process of applied education. See Main Topics on the seminary website for a description of the process.

In accord with our philosophy that analytical research is more important than cramming for examinations, credits may be provided for each, thorough, research assignment that proves adequate knowledge of any subject.

Credit, will be given for prior learning and life experience and such credit can be applied as replacement for **any subject** as long as such experiential credit is given for experience that relates to a particular degree program. Experiential credit assessment will be based on the completion your evaluation.

24- Credits are provided for completion of the manuals and workbooks for Learning Modules, One and Two.

Christian Life Development Learning Module Three in conjunction with prior life, learning experience credit may combine to provide the total 120credit hour requirement for a Bachelor Degree, in some cases, depending on the quality and volume of prior life learning experience that is submitted for assessment, in conjunction with performance on the initial evaluation examination and the Bible Book Knowledge Evaluation
