Experiential credit assessment will be based on the completion your evaluation.

24- credits is provided for completion of the manuals and workbooks for each of the Christian Life Development Learning Modules, One and Two.

Christian Life Development Learning Module Three in conjunction with prior life, learning experience credit may combine to provide the total 120-credit hour requirement for a Bachelor Degree, in some cases, depending on the quality and volume of prior life learning experience that is submitted for assessment.
